The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

The minutes of the regular meeting of March 14th and special meeting of March 20th were read and approved.

The bond of A. C. Schwenker for Two Thousand Dollars as City Scavenger was presented and read.

The bond of A. C. Schwenker having been examined and approved by the Acting City Attorney, it was moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the bond be accepted and placed on file. The motion carried unanimously.

The proposed agreement between the City and the Rio Grande Junction Railway^{Co.} covering crossing at Thirteenth Street, having been examined and reported favorably by the Acting City Attorney, the following resolution was introduced and read:

Be it Resolved, That the contract covering use of right of way for wagon road crossing over the track and roadbed of The Rio Grande^{Junction} Railway Company, in form as just read be entered into by the City of Grand
