All the Commissioners having been duly notified, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was held at 9 o'clock a.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Scovill, Kolmburg, Absent: Commissioner Vedder.

Acting City Attorney Tupper was present.

The following resolution was introduced and read:

Whereas, Ordinance No. 188, an ordinance to provide for establishing and maintaining permanent registration lists of all qualified electors in election precincts within the City of Grand Junction, for use in municipal elections; to provide for punishing all violations thereof, and for the appointment of judges for special elections where no candidates are to be voted on, is now in full force and effect, and

Whereas, the City Clerk has had a copy made in registration books of all the names and all the data connected

therewith, as provided in Section 2 of said Ordinance No. 188; therefore be it

Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, that the City Clerk be and hereby is instructed to give public notice, by advertisement for four consecutive insertions in the two daily newspapers published in the city, that the registration lists are at the office of the City Clerk open for inspection, and that qualified electors may register or make changes in their registration, as in said Ordinance No. 188 provided.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

Resolution adopted of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and the resolution passed and adopted.

Adjourned On motion of Commissioner Holmberg, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, the Council adjourned.
