Regular Meeting

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Minutes approved

The minutes of the regular meeting of April 11th and adjourned session of April 12th were read and approved.

Quarterly Report of Com. of Highways

The quarterly report of the Commissioner of Highways was presented and read, and on motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the report was referred to the auditor.

Report on Petition

Mayor Todd, to whom had been referred the petition of Mrs. E. K. Sullivan and others for an arc light at the intersection of Rood avenue and Third street, reported adversely on said petition, stating that, as there was now an arc light at Rood avenue and second street, he recommended the petition be not granted.
