Adjourned

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened, pursuant to adjournment, at 4 o'clock p.m., in the Council Chamber,

City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll Call

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Kolmburg.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg that in purchasing a rock crusher for the City, the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be instructed to order a new machine.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, no; Kolmburg, yea.

Motion Carried

A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Com of Fin + Supplies instructed to order an Aurora No. 1 Rock Crusher

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be authorized and instructed to place an order for an Aurora No. 1 Rock Crusher for the city.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, no; Kolmburg, yea.

A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Com of Water Sewers instructed to secure bids for manholes, Sewer Dist No. 3

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, that the Commissioner of Water and Sewers be instructed to secure bids for the building of the manholes and flush tanks for the new sewers to be constructed in Sewer District No. 3.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Kolmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.
