On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, the communication was referred to the Mayor and the Commissioner of Highways.

A communication from the George Pierce Testing Laboratories of Portland, Colorado, in reference to inspecting and testing cement for the city, was read.

Motion by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the Clerk be instructed to draw a warrant for \$3.50 in favor of A. Nelson, for refund on water rental paid on property at 1028 North Fifth street, and that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be instructed to collect said amount from R. L. Magill, the owner or agent of said property.
