Regular meeting

Yesterday being a legal holiday, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened this day in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Kolmburg. Acting City Attorney Tupper was present.

Minutes approved

The minutes of the regular meeting of May 23<sup>d</sup>, and adjourned sessions of May 26<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> were read and approved.

Reports of City Treas and City Clerk accepted

The quarterly report of the City Treasurer having been examined and approved by the auditor, the same was, on motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, accepted and ordered placed on file.

The quarterly report of the City Clerk, having been examined and found correct by the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, the same was on motion of Commissioner Scovill, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, accepted and ordered placed on file.

Motion fixing salaries of City Eng. and assist- and engineers

Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that in connection with the engineering work of sewer construction, paving and extension of water works, George L. Crawford, city engineer, be paid a salary of \$300<sup>00</sup> per month; that E. M. Romberg, assistant engineer, be paid a salary of \$125<sup>00</sup> per month, and that John Patton, instrument man, be paid at the rate of \$100<sup>00</sup> per month.

Bills allowed All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and the bills allowed.

Proof of Publication of Proposed Ordinance Accepted The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled, "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," was presented and read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the proof of publication as read be accepted and placed on file. The motion carried.

Proposed Ordinance Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, that the proposed ordinance be now taken up for final passage. The motion carried, and the proposed ordinance was thereupon read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the second paragraph of Section 4 of the proposed ordinance, and reading, "In all cases where fire hydrants, or other water connections, are maintained," etc., be stricken out.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Kolmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion Carried, and it was so ordered.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, that the proposed ordinance as read and amended, and entitled, "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," be passed and adopted.
