Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, that the city rent the building known as the "Labor Temple", on the lot adjoining the City Hall, for the use of the City Engineer, at a rental of \$25⁰⁰ per month, from May 15th to November 15th, 1911.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Kolmburg, yea. All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

The bill of Laura Sawyer for rent of building for office of City Engineer, from May 15th to Aug. 15th, @ 25⁰⁰ per month, for \$75⁰⁰, was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the bill of Laura Sawyer for \$75⁰⁰, three months rent of building for office of City Engineer, be allowed and warrant ordered drawn on the Sewer No. 3 fund for the amount.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Kolmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and the bill allowed.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, the Council adjourned to Thursday, June 15th, at 4 o'clock p. m.
