Regular meeting

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber, City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Minutes approved

The minutes of the regular meeting of June 13<sup>th</sup>, adjourned sessions of June 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>, and Special meeting of June 17<sup>th</sup>, were read and approved.

Ask for Establishment of Municipal wood pile
