Meeting

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in adjourned session at 4 o'clock P.M. in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the Chair.

Motion

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that Commissioner Scovill act as Clerk protem during the absence of Commissioner Kolmburg.

Carried

The motion being put it was <sup>carried</sup> unanimously.

Roll call

Upon call of roll the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck and Scovill

Acting City Attorney Tupper was present

Motion

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the City enter into a contract with T. H. Williams, for all the sand gravel & Rock that will be used paving District No. 1, for not to exceed (\$250<sup>00</sup>) Two hundred Fifty & no/100 Dollars.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea.

Carried

All the Commissioners present having voted yea the Mayor declared the motion carried

Motion

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Scovill that Commissioner Vorbeck, and City Engineer Geo. L. Crawford go to Denver and buy all the Machinery & Supplies that is needed for paving District No. 1.

Carried

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.
