Adjourned
Session

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in adjourned session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Holmberg.

City Attorney Bucklin was present.

The communication from E. W. Rollins & Sons, and A. B. Leach & Co., presented and read at the previous meeting, was again taken up and read, but no action was taken in reference to same.

A communication from W. H. Gmeiner in reference to supervising the work of paving in Paving District No. 1, was read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, that Mr. W. H. Gmeiner be employed by the City as foreman for street paving work, at \$5⁰⁰ per day, his services to begin on Monday, July 24th, 1911.
