Attention having been called to the excavation on the vacant lots at the corner of Main and Seventh streets reaching a depth so as to endanger pedestrians, the matter of having the said excavation protected was, on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Kolmberg, referred to the Mayor.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the following resolution be passed and adopted:

Whereas, It appears from the reports of the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, and from the records, that the surplus funds now in the City Treasury which has, and is accumulating from the sale of the Sewer and Paving bonds, is, and will be, beyond the immediate needs of these works, and

Whereas, the deposit of these funds bring no interest to the city, and

Whereas, the City has outstanding warrants to a considerable amount which are drawing 6 per cent. interest, and

Whereas, it is desirable to save all

the money possible for the city; be it therefore
Resolved, That the Commissioner of
 Finance and Supplies be authorized to use
 as much of ~~such~~ surplus in his hands
 from time to time, as he may deem
 safe and wise, to buy up some of the
 outstanding city warrants, and carry such
 warrants in his cash balance until such
 are called in and paid from such fund
 against which they are drawn.
