Adjourned
session

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in adjourned session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon

Roll call call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Holmburg.

Application for Electric sign referred. The application of Josephine Steadman and Mayme Olive Perlee, for permit to erect an illuminated sign was read, and on motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the same was referred to the Mayor and the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty.

Report of Com. Water and Sewers accepted. The quarterly report of the Commissioner of Water and Sewers having been examined and approved by the Auditor, the report was, on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, accepted and ordered placed on file.

Report of City Treas. accepted. The quarterly report of the City Treasurer having been examined and found correct by the Auditor, the report was, on motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, accepted and ordered placed on file.

Motion carried. Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the matter of renting a concrete mixer for the street paving work be referred to the Commissioner of Highways and the Mayor. The motion carried.

Motion carried. Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the matter of securing power for the rock crusher and other machinery for paving work be referred to the Commissioner of Highways and the Mayor. The motion carried.

Motion to Commence Paving at Second & Main Sts carried. Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the Council order that the paving work in Paving District No. 1 be commenced at the corner of Main and second streets, and that the first work of paving be carried done on Main street.
