

Grand Junction, Colorado, August 22, 1911.

Regular
meeting

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Vedder, Acting Mayor, in the chair.

Roll call.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Vedder, Scovill, Kolmberg. Absent: Mayor Todd and Commissioner Vorbeck.

A quorum being present, the Council proceeded to business.

The regular order of business being suspended, the following resolution was introduced and read:

Whereas, there has been deposited with the Grand Valley National Bank, of Grand Junction, Colorado, to the credit of the City of Grand Junction, a sum of money in excess of \$189,932.36; and

Whereas, the judgment and interest in the case of The City of Grand Junction versus Wm. Van Pelt, et al, in the District Court of the Seventh Judicial

District of the State of Colorado, in and for the County of Mesa, now amounts to the sum of \$189,932.36, which sum of money under the terms of the judgment in said cause heretofore entered on the 30 day of March, A. D. 1911, shall be paid to the Mesa County National Bank, of Grand Junction, Colorado, as Registrar of the said Court, for the uses and purposes set forth in said judgment; and

Whereas, H. F. Vorbeck, the duly elected, qualified and acting Treasurer of the City of Grand Junction, is now absent from the said city, and is not available for the purpose of signing a check upon said Grand Valley National Bank, for the said sum of \$189,932.36, for the purpose of securing the draft with which to pay the said judgment and interest into the said The Mesa County National Bank;

Therefore, Be it Resolved, that B. W. Vedder is hereby appointed Acting Treasurer of the said city for the purpose of signing said check for the purposes heretofore stated.

Moved by Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Scovill, yea; Kolmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Acting Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and adopted.

On motion of Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, the Council adjourned until to-morrow, Wednesday, August 23^d, at 4 o'clock p. m.
