Adjourned
Session

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Scovill, Kolmburg. Absent: Commissioner Vorbeck. City Attorney Bucklin was present.

Moved by Commissioner Scovill, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that all bids for staves for wood pipe be rejected and the certifica checks accompanying bids returned to the several bidders.
