The communication from Arthur F. McDuffie, acting U.S. Forest Supervisor, in reference to permit to use one acre of land in Section 34, Township 12, South, Range 97 west, 6th P. M., for the purpose of building a watchman's house at head gate of Kannah Creek pipe line and for the purpose of constructing diverting dam across Kannah Creek, was read.

Moved by Commissioner Scovill, seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be instructed to send five dollars to the U.S. Depository in Denver as the first annual payment on account of use of ground for watchman's house at intake of Kannah Creek pipe line and for constructing diverting dam.

presented and read.

city the agreement between the City of
Grand Junction and the Portland Wood Pipe
Company as prepared and read.
