

Grand Junction, Colorado, October 3, 1911.

Regular Meeting The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Scovill, Holmberg. Absent: Commissioner Vorhede. City Attorney Bucklin was present.

Minutes approved The minutes of the regular meeting of September 26<sup>th</sup> and adjourned session of September 30<sup>th</sup> were read and approved.

Petition Referred The petition of the Mesa County Bank for permit to erect electric signs at their place of business, corner Fourth and Main, was presented and read. On motion of Commissioner Scovill, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the petition was referred to the Mayor and City Clerk with power to act.
