

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 16th, 1911.

Adjourned
Session

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 2:30 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the Chair.

Roll call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Holmberg. Absent: Commissioners Vedder and Rankin.

City Attorney Bucklin was present.

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Vorbeck and read by the Clerk:

Resolution

Be it Resolved, By the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the said City of Grand Junction for the next fiscal year, beginning January 1, 1912, and ending December 31, 1912, there shall be and hereby is levied and assessed upon all the taxable property situated within the corporate limits of said City of Grand Junction, both real and personal, the following amounts for special and general taxes, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of defraying the expenses and maintenance of the free Public Library, a tax of three-fourths of one ($\frac{3}{4}$ of 1) mill on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

2^d. For the purpose of advertising the City of Grand Junction and of fostering and encouraging manufactures and home industries, a tax of one mill on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

3^d. For the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of said City of Grand Junction, and for the payment of interest on outstanding bonds and warrants, a tax of twenty-five and one-fourth ($25\frac{1}{4}$) mills

is hereby assessed on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed; and be it further

Resolved, That the City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to certify to the foregoing levy to the County Clerk and Recorder, and also to the County Assessor, of Mesa County, Colorado, for levy by the vote of the County Commissioners as required by the statutes of the State of Colorado, and as provided also by the Charter of the said City of Grand Junction.

Moved by Commissioner Holmberg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the resolution as introduced and read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and adopted.

The official bond of James W. Rankin, as Commissioner of Highways, having been examined and approved by the City Attorney, it was moved by Commissioner Holmberg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the bond be accepted and ordered placed on file.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bond accepted.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, the Council adjourned until Monday, November 20th, at 4 o'clock p.m.
