Adjourned

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened, pursuant to adjournment, at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Poll call Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Rankin, Holmberg. Absent: Commissioner Vedder.

City Attorney Bucklin was present.

Bond of Dr. Carl W. Plumb, City Health Officer, having been examined and approved by the City Attorney, the bond was on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, accepted and ordered placed on file.

The following bills, having been approved by heads of departments and audited, were read by the Clerk:
