

Adjourned
session

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 1st, 1911.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Holmberg. Absent: Commissioner Rankin.

City Attorney Bucklin was present.

Proposed Ordinance

The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled "The Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, Providing for the Expenses and Liabilities of the City of Grand Junction for the Fiscal Year Beginning January 1st, A.D. 1912, and Ending December 31st, A.D. 1912," was read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Holmberg, seconded

by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the proof of publication as read be accepted and placed on file.

The motion carried, and the proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, that Section 1 of the proposed ordinance be so amended that the Appropriation for the Fire Department be reduced to \$5,300.⁰⁰, and the appropriation for Lighting the Streets and Public Buildings be increased to \$7,700.⁰⁰; also that the appropriation for maintaining and operating the city water works be increased to \$11,700.⁰⁰.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmberg, yea.

^{Carried} All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the proposed ordinance, as amended, was taken up for final passage, and read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, that the ordinance as amended and read and entitled, "The Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, Providing for the Expenses and Liabilities of the City of Grand Junction for the Fiscal Year Beginning January 1st, A. D. 1912, and Ending December 31st, 1912," be passed and adopted.

The bona of A. Goodman, applicant for a plumber's license, having been examined and approved by the City Attorney, it was moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the said A. Goodman be granted a plumber's license for the balance of the current fiscal year.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the license granted.

Motion to Pay bill for light Conduits out of several funds. Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the bill of the Grand Junction Electric, Gas & Manufacturing Co., for material and fittings for electric light conduits be paid out of the light fund, as much thereof as the said fund may permit, and that the balance of said bill be paid out of the Police, Fire and General funds.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and it was so ordered.

Motion to appoint Claude Hedrick regular fireman. Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that Claude Hedrick be appointed as a regular fireman for the term of one year.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion

carried, and Claude Hedrick appointed as a regular fireman.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the Council adjourn.

Adjourned. The motion carried, and the Council then adjourned.
