

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 16, 1911.

*Adjourned session* The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

*Roll call.* Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Rankin, Holmberg. Absent: Commissioner Vedder.

*Petition laid on the Table* The petition of Wm. E. Graham and others in reference to the improvement of the children's park was presented and read to the Council.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the petition was laid on the table.
