

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 21st, 1911.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Rankin, Kolmburg. Absent: Commissioner Vedder.

Communication read and filed.

A communication from W. W. Martin, making application for the position of care-taker at intake of Kannah Creek pipe line, was read, and on motion of Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the communication was ordered placed on file.
