The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Rankin, Kolmburg.

City Attorney Bucklin was present.

Moved by Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Commissioner of Water and Sewers be instructed to notify the persons drawing water from Artesian well No. 1 to have repairs made at said well according to the directions of the Commissioner of Water and Sewers.

The motion carried.

On the petition of A. Goodman for a plumber's license, referred to Commissioner Vedder, the said Commissioner reported favorably, and

recommended that a license be granted to said petitioner.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Rankin that a license be granted to A. Goodman to carry on the business of plumbing.

The motion carried.

City Engineer Geo. L. Crawford having asked the Council for a leave of absence, the matter of his compensation during such absence was referred to the Mayor and Commissioner Vedder, who recommended that the salary of the City engineer, during his absence, be at the rate of \$50 per month and that he be allowed traveling expenses one way.
