Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the resignation of Fred Shaffer as Director of Publicity be accepted, the resignation to date from May 1st.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called, voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the resignation of Mr. Shaffer accepted.

The special joint committee of members of the city council and directors of the Chamber of Commerce submitted report and recommended the appointment of E. Antles as Director of Publicity at a salary of \$80 per month.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the report of the committee be accepted and that E. Antles be employed by the council as Director of Publicity at a salary of \$80. per month, his appointment to date from May 15th, 1912.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and E. Antles duly appointed as Director of Publicity.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council then adjourned.
