

Grand Junction, Colorado, May 14th, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Vedder, acting Mayor, in the chair.

Upon call of roll the following Commissioners responded as present: Vedder, Verbeck, Helmburg. Absent Commissioners Todd and Rankin.

Acting City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of May 7th and adjourned session of May 9th were read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that James Purcell be granted a permit to make addition to the building at 451 Main street, according to plans and specifications as submitted and prepared by J. B. Boyer, architect.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the permit granted.

Commissioner Verbeck of the special committee on advertising made report and recommended that the city make contract for one-fourth page space in the Inter-Mountain Fruit Journal for six months, at \$12.50 for each insertion.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the report of the committee be accepted and that a contract be entered into by the City with the Inter-Mountain Fruit Journal for one-fourth page of advertising space for six months, at the rate of \$12.50 for each monthly insertion.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the acting Mayor declared the motion carried, and it was so ordered.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the bills as read be allowed and warrants ordered drawn for the several amounts.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the bills allowed.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the city janitor be allowed a salary of \$25.00 per month from and after May 1st.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as had his name was called voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

Commissioner Rankin now reported present.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the City purchase for the use of the City Clerk the roll-top office desk from Mr. Bickel at \$25.00, the same to be paid for out of the General Fund.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council then adjourned.
