

Friday April 21st 1905 at 9 Pm

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction Colorado
convened pursuant to adjournment. Mayor L. N. Bunting
presiding. Upon call of the roll the following
named Alderman responded Present.

Alkire - Lute Davis - Luter - McCulloch - Norris - Bayle
 Platt - Smith and City Attorney N.E. Coler. Thereupon
 Mayor J.N. Bunting addressed Council in regard to their
 tabling the Contest Cases of W.H. Gannister vs. J.A. McCulloch
 and W.E. Stockton vs. J.W. Norris Alderman Bayle
 takes exception to Mayor Bunting in regard to Contest of
 W.E. Stockton vs. J.W. Norris of the First Ward
 Alderman Bayle enters a motion to lay Contest on
 the table and proceed to elect the Superintendent of
 water works Mayor Bunting declares his motion
 out of order. Alderman Platt enters motion that
 Contest Cases of W.H. Gannister vs. J.A. McCulloch of
 third Ward and W.E. Stockton vs. J.W. Norris of first Ward
 be taken from table and proceed with both Cases on
 Tuesday 8 Pm April 25th 1905. upon Call of Roll Vote
 was as follows Alderman Alkire yea Davis yea
 Luter yea McCulloch nay Norris yea Bayle nay
 Platt yea Smith yea there being 5 yeas & 3 nays said
 motion was carried and so declared by the Mayor.
 A motion was entered by Alderman Platt to adjourn
 until 8 Pm Tuesday April 25th 1905 seconded by
 Alderman Davis upon Call of Roll Vote was
 as follows Alderman Alkire yea Davis yea
 Luter yea McCulloch nay Norris yea Bayle nay
 Platt yea Smith yea there being 6 yeas & 2 nays
 said motion Carried and was so declared by the Mayor
 9⁴⁰ Pm
