

Grand Junction, Colorado, June 18th, 1912.

Regular Meeting

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Holmberg. Absent: Commissioners Vedder and Rankin.

Quorum present

A quorum being present, the Council proceeded to business.

Motion carried

Acting City Attorney Tupper was present. Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, that the two and three room houses owned by Mrs. Vaughn be rated, for water rental, as one five-room house.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and it was so ordered.

Minutes approved

The minutes of the regular meeting of June 4th and adjourned sessions of June 7th, and June 10th; also of the regular meeting of June 11th, were read and approved.
