

Grand Junction, Colorado, July 9th, 1912

Regular meeting. The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call. The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Kolmburg. Absent: Commissioners Vedder and Rankin.

Minutes approved. City Attorney Bucklin was present. The minutes of the regular meetings of June 25th and July 2^d were read and approved.

Communications. A communication from A. E. Matthews of the Colorado Fuel & Iron Company was read and on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, the same was ordered placed on file.

A communication from J. Monroe Stewart, in reference to granting street concessions to the Mesa County Industrial and Fair Association during fair week in September, was read and on motion of Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the same was laid on the table until next regular meeting of the Council.

Report of City Weigher. The monthly report of the City Weigher was submitted and read, and on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Kolmburg, the same was referred to the Mayor.

Report of Fire Chief. The quarterly report of the Chief of the Fire Department having been examined and approved by the Mayor, the same was, on motion of Commissioner Kolmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, accepted and ordered placed on file.
