

Grand Junction, Colorado, July 23d, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Verbeck, Rankin. Absent: Commissioners Vedder and Holmburg.

The minutes of the regular meeting of July 16th and adjourned session of July 20th were read and approved.

A communication from the Beaver Dam Malleable Iron Co. was read, and on motion of Commissioner Verbeck the same was received and ordered filed.

A communication from the Pacific Lumber Agency was read, and on motion of Commissioner Verbeck the same was received and ordered placed on file.

O. G. Coen, being present, stated his reasons for asking damages by reason of water pipe line crossing his land on Orchard Mesa. The matter was deferred for de-

cision until Commissioner Vedder should be present.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeek, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the Council adjourned until Saturday, July 27th, at 4 o'clock p. m.
