

Grand Junction, Colorado, July 27th, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners upon call of roll responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeck, Rankin. Absent: Commissioner Helmburg.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the license granted to C. W. Dowler & Co. be transferred to Starkey & Simmons.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

The petition of Henry R. Rhene and others, asking that a proposed amendment of Article 10 of the Charter of Grand Junction be submitted to the qualified electors at a special election, was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the petition be filed, and that it be referred to Commissioner Verbeck to count the names and report as to whether it contains ten per cent. or more of the number of votes cast at the last election for Governor.

The motion being put, on call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Mr. O. G. Coen appeared before the Council in reference to his claim for \$194.50.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that Mr. Coen be allowed \$25.00 in full settlement of his claim for work on the ditch.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Mr. O. G. Coen thereupon refused to accept \$25.00 for full settlement of said claim.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the Council then adjourned.
