The City Council of the City of Grand Junetien convened in regular adjourned session at 4 e'clock p. m., in the City Hall with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Meved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the Council reconsider the resolution passed at the regular meeting held July 30, 1912, in reference to submitting to a vote of the people the question of entering linto negotiations for the purchase of the Grand Junction electric light plant.

Commissioner Verbeck also seconded the metion to reconsider the resolution, and addressed the Council and others present, stating his position and views upon the question involved in the resolution.

The metien being put, each Cemmissiener as his name was called veted as fellows:
Tedd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

The resolution was then taken up for reconsideration, and it was moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the resolution in reference to submitting to a vote of the people at the next special election the question of entering into negetiations for the purchase of the Grand Junction electric light plant, be laid on the table.

The metien being put, upon call of rell the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Helmburg, yea. All the Commissioners present having veted yea, the Mayer declared the metien carried and the resolution tabled.
