

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 3, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Todd in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeck, Rankin, Helmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of November 26th and adjourned session of November 30th were read and approved.

The petition of Charles Garber and others, asking the Council to have an arc light placed at the intersection of South Seventh street and Struthers avenue, was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, the petition was referred to the Mayor.

The monthly report of the City Weigher was submitted and read, and on motion of Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, the same was referred to the Mayor.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Approving the Whole Cost of the Improvements Made in and for Paving District Number Four, in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 178, Adopted and Approved June 11, 1910, and Pursuant to Resolutions and Proceedings of the City Council adopted Pursuant to said Ordinance No. 178, Approving the Apportionment of said Cost to each Lot or Tract of Land in Said District, and Prescribing the Manner for the Collection and Payment of said Assessment," was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the proof of publication as read be accepted and placed on file.

The motion carried, and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the proposed ordinance was then taken up for final passage, and read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the proposed ordinance as read and entitled, "An Ordinance Approving the Whole Cost of the Improvements Made in and for Paving District Number Four, in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado,



Pursuant to Ordinance No. 178, adopted and approved June 11, 1910, and Pursuant to the Resolutions and Proceedings of the City Council adopted Pursuant to said Ordinance No. 178, Approving the Apportionment of said Cost to each Lot or Tract of Land in said District, Assessing the Share of said Cost Against each Lot or Tract of Land in said District, and Prescribing the Manner for the Collection and Payment of said Assessment," be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 205.

The motion carried, and it was so ordered.

The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the proof of publication as read be accepted and placed on file.

The motion carried, and it was so ordered.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the proposed ordinance be taken up for final passage.

The motion carried, and the proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the proposed ordinance as read and entitled, "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 206.

The motion carried, and it was so ordered.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the Daily News be designated as the official newspaper of the City of Grand Junction from this date until July 1st, 1913.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the Daily News made the official newspaper of the City until July 1st, 1913.

The following resolution was introduced and read:

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, there has been paid out of the Water Fund Five Hundred (\$500.) Dollars for labor and material in the extension of water



mains and other new work, which amount should properly have been paid out of the Special Water Fund; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that there be, and hereby is, transferred from the Special Water Fund to the Water Fund the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.) Dollars.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and the resolution passed and adopted.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council then adjourned.
