Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the proposed ordinance as read and entitled, "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," be passed and adopted.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and adopted.

Meved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 206.

The metien carried, and it was se eredered.

Meved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the Daily News be designated as the efficial newspaper of the City of Grand Junction from this date until July 1st, 1913.

The metien being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, veted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the Daily News made the official newspaper of the City until July 1st, 1913.

The following resolution was introduced and read:

WHEREAS, there has been paid out of the Water Fund Five Hundred (\$500.) Dellars for labor and material in the extension of water

mains and other new work, which amount should properly have been paid out of the Special Water Fund; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that there be, and hereby is, transferred from the Special Water Fund to the Water Fund the sum of Five Hundred (3500.) Dellars.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Felmburg, that the reselution as read be passed and adopted.

The metien being put, upon call of rell, the Commissioners veted as fellows: Tedd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeek, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the metion carried, and the resolution passed and adopted.

On metien of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, the Council then adjourned. Charles K Holmburg
