

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 10, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Tedd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Tedd, Vedder, Verbeck, Rankin, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

A communication from the Grand Junction Electric, Gas & Manufacturing Co., in reference to the payment of bill for water used by said company, was read by the Clerk. On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, the communication was ordered placed on file.

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the City Engineer be instructed to prepare a new map of the City of Grand Junction, and that one-fourth of the cost of such work be paid for out of the Water Fund and three-fourths of the same out of the General Fund.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Tedd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned.
