

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 17, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Todd in the chair.

The monthly report of the City Weigher having been examined and approved by the Mayor, the same was on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, accepted and ordered placed on file.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the following resolution be passed and adopted:

WHEREAS, it has been the custom for a number of years past to pay the salaries of city officers and regular employes for the month of December before Christmas, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that the Mayor and City Clerk be, and hereby are, authorized and instructed to issue the warrants in payment of the December salaries of all city officers and employes on or before December 20, 1912.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and adopted.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the Council adjourned.
