

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 23, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in special session, at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Verbeck, Rankin, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Vedder.

The Labor Account of the Department of Highways, amounting to \$97.35, having been approved by the Commissioner of Highways and audited, it was moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the same be allowed and warrants ordered drawn in favor of the several employes appearing thereon.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the labor account allowed.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned.
