

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 24, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Verbeck, Rankin, Helmburg. Absent: Commissioner Vedder.

The following bills having been approved by heads of departments and audited, were read by the Clerk:

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the bills as read be allowed and warrants ordered drawn for the several amounts.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

The depository bond of the Mesa County National Bank having been examined and approved by the City Attorney, the same was, on motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the Mayor and Commissioner Rankin were appointed a special committee to interview the several persons whose names had been suggested for members of the Civil Service Commission to be appointed by the Council before January 1st next.

The following resolution was introduced and read:

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has in his possession a number of warrants issued against the several funds of the City and dating back two or more years, and

WHEREAS, the said warrants have never been called for by those to whom they were issued, and it therefore appearing to the Council that said warrants were issued on account of errors in pay rolls or for duplicate claims, or claims already paid; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that the City Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized and instructed to cancel all warrants now in his hands and dated prior to July 1st, 1912, and numbered as follows: General and Miscellaneous Funds: 3,678, 4,319, 6,391, 6,393, 6,395, 6,398, 7,167, 7,169, 7,361, 7,793, 8,166, 8,263, 8,497, 8,725, 8,744, 9,079, 9,546, 9,551, 9,553, 9,742, 9,880, 9,892, 10,116, 10,397, 10,743, 11,462; Kannah Creek Fund: 120, 406, 411, 600, 861, 1026, 1391.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Council adjourn.

The motion carried, and the Council then adjourned.
