

Grand Junction, Colorado, August 29, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeek, Helmburg. Absent: Commissioner Rankin.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeek, that the bids submitted to the Council yesterday for paving work be rejected, and that the certified checks accompanying same be returned to the bidders.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows:

Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeek, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

The following resolution was introduced and read:

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Grand Junction Electric, Gas & Manufacturing Company is using between 600,000 and 700,000 gallons of water per month, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable for various reasons to put the said company on a flat rate; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the said company be put on a flat rate of \$70.00 per month for a maximum amount of 700,000 gallons per month, which rate shall apply from July 1st, 1912.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows:

Todd, no; Vedder, yea; Verbeek, yea; Holmburg, yea.

A majority of the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and adopted.

Mr. Caffrey having applied to the Council for permission to repair the building at 739 Reed Avenue, with brick veneered walls, it was moved by Commissioner Verbeek, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that permission be granted to make such repairs.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeek, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the permission granted.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.
