

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 7, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Vedder, Acting Mayor, in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Vedder, Verbeck, Rankin, Helmburg. Absent: Mayor Todd.

The petition of Milton Hockett and others, asking the Council to order a cement sidewalk constructed on the east side of Fourth street from Teller avenue to the alley at the Hawthorne school, was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the petition be granted and the sidewalk petitioned for be ordered constructed.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the sidewalk ordered constructed.
