

Grand Junction, Colorado, September 17, 1912.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Todd in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeek, Rankin, Helmburg.

The minutes of the regular meeting of September 10th were read and approved.

The petition of Josephine Rich and others, asking the Council to install a six-inch water main on North Seventh street where a two-inch main is now laid and to place fire plugs at proper distances, was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Verbeek, the petition was referred to the Commissioner of Water and Sewers.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeek, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be authorized and instructed to place order for one 5-ten Irquois

tandem road roller, a 400-gal. portable melting pot, 2 asphalt cutters, etc., as per requisition of the Commissioner of Highways, for Paving District No. 2.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be authorized and instructed to order one carload of steel pipe for water main extensions.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the Mayor be instructed to employ the Grand Junction City Band to give concerts on Main street for three nights during the week of the Mesa County Fair.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that Mr. J. W. Bucklin be employed to make a complete revision of the City Ordinances, and that he be allowed for said legal work the sum of \$600.00, and not to exceed an additional \$100.00 for stenographic work.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, the Council adjourned until to-morrow, September 18th, at 4 o'clock p. m.
