Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, that Mr. J. W. Bucklin be employed to make a complete revision of the City Ordinances, and that he be allowed for said legal work the sum of \$600.00, and not to exceed an additional \$100.00 for stenographic work.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.
