

Grand Junction, Colorado, April 11, 1913.

All the Commissioners having been duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in special session at 2 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeck, Rankin, Helmburg.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the Mayor be instructed to appoint 20 deputy policemen to be on duty to-night.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, that the Council request the Sheriff of Mesa County to co-operate with the city authorities in case of an emergency.

The motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, the Council adjourned.
