

Grand Junction, Colorado, April 12, 1913.

Upon the notification of all the Commissioners, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was held at 2 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Todd presiding.

A communication from S. B. Hutchinsen, tendering his resignation as Chief of Police, was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the resignation of S. B. Hutchinsen as Chief of Police be accepted, and that the resignation take effect Wednesday morning, April 16th, 1913.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea; Mayer Todd not voting.

A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and the resignation of S. B. Hutchinsen accepted.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the Council adjourned.
