The metien carried and the prepesed erdinance was then read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the ordinance as read and entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to Licenses," be passed and adopted.

The metion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the acting Mayer declared the metion carried and the ordinance passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 211.

The metion carried, and it was se erdered.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, the Council adjourned.
