

Grand Junction, Colorado, July 5th, 1913.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeek, Rankin, Holmburg.

The minutes of the regular meeting of July 1st were read and approved.

The monthly report of the City Weigher having been examined and approved by the Mayor, the same was on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, accepted and ordered placed on file.

The quarterly report of the Public Librarian was submitted and read. On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the report was referred to the auditor.

The City Treasurer's report for the second quarter of the current fiscal year was submitted and read, and on motion of Commissioner Verbeek, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the same was referred to the auditor.
