

Grand Junction, Colorado, March 11, 1913.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeck, Rankin, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of March 4th were read and approved.

A communication from the advertising committee of the Chamber of Commerce, recommending that the City take a quarter page advertising space in the Intermountain Fruit Journal for six months, was read.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the recommendations of the Chamber of Commerce be ratified by the Council and that a contract be entered into with the Intermountain Fruit Journal for one-quarter<sup>r</sup><sub>^</sub> page advertising space in said journal for six months, at \$14.50 per issue.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

A communication from Wm. E. Sweet & Co., of Denver, in reference to their contract for option on the \$21,000 of bonds of Paving District No. 3, and stating that they would exercise said option, was read.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be instructed to write Wm. E. Sweet & Co. and inform them that all preliminary proceedings relating to the formation of the said Paving District No. 3 have been taken and the bonds printed, and to notify said firm that <sup>\$3,000 of</sup> the bonds of said paving district will be issued <sup>at once and the balance</sup> on or about June 1st, 1913.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the Council adjourned.
