

Grand Junction, Colorado, May 20, 1913.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at 4 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vorbeck, Helmburg. Absent: Commissioners Vedder and Rankin.

The minutes of the regular meeting of May 13th and adjourned session of May 19th were read and approved.

A communication from N. C. Miller and Henry Tupper, rendering an opinion to the Council on the question as to whether the City has the authority to acquire by condemnation the electric light plant of the Grand Junction Electric, Gas & Manufacturing Company, was submitted and read.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, the communication was received and ordered placed on file.

The reports of the City Weigher for the months of March and April having been examined and approved by the Mayor, the same were, on motion of Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, accepted and ordered placed on file.

The quarterly report of the Chief of the Fire Department having been examined and

approved by the Mayor, the same was, on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, accepted and ordered placed on file.

The quarterly report of the City Clerk having been examined and approved by the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, the same was, on motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, accepted and ordered placed on file.
