

Grand Junction, Colorado, October 20, 1913.

All the Commissioners having been duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in special session at 2 o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Verbeck, Rankin, Holmburg.

The Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, pursuant to the provisions of the Charter, submitted to the Council the Annual City Estimate of the receipts and disbursements for the Fiscal Year beginning January 1st, 1914; also the amount of uncalled outstanding city warrants at this date.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the annual city estimate, as submitted by the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, be received and filed with the City Clerk.

The motion carried, and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the Council adjourned.
