In the Schedule of assessments of sidewalk district no. 1. you have charged in Block 1 Grand River Sub-division, against lot 13, the amount of \$4.75, which seems to be an over charge for the peice of walk laid. A piece 42 by 5 sq. ft. making 222 sq. ft. © .12 per ft. which would amount to \$2.70 the way I would figure it out.

Horing you will investigate, and notify me of the results.

And whereas a hearing has been regularly and legally held on said objection, the said T. F. Flucken being present,

and being heard, and the Council being fully advised in the premises, it is hereby resolved and ordered that the assessment against Lot 13 of Block 1, in Grand River Sub-division in said City, be reduced from \$4.75 to \$3.10.

And, be it further resolved, that the time under said ordinance as amended for filing objections of any kind against acceptances of said work, and the assessment therefore has now expired, and the said improvement is hereby confirmed, all in pursuance of said Ordinance.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Carson, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

On roll call, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Carson, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the Council adjourn to Friday, December 10th, at 4 o'clock p. m.

The motion carried, and the Council adjourned until above date.
