

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 12, 1913.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 4 o'clock, p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

On roll call, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Verbeck, Rankin, Carson. Absent: Commissioner Holmburg.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Approving the Whole Cost of Improvements made in and for Sidewalk District Number 1 in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, pursuant to Ordinance No. 175, adopted and approved June 11, 1910, as amended by Ordinance Number 205, adopted and approved March 4, 1913, and pursuant to Resolutions and Proceedings of the City Council, adopted pursuant to said Ordinances approving the Apportionment of said costs to each Lot or Tract of Land, or other Real Estate in said District, Assessing the Share of said cost against each Lot, or Tract of Land, or other Real Estate in said District, and Prescribing the Manner for the Collection and Payment of said Assessments," was introduced, and read by the acting Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Carson, that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows:

Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

~~A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Providing for an Emergency Appropriation for the Maintenance of the City Water Works," was introduced by Commissioner Carson and read by the acting clerk.~~

~~Moved by Commissioner Carson, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed and adopted.~~

~~The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea.~~

~~All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and the ordinance passed and adopted.~~

~~Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Carson, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 217, and that the same be ordered published in the official newspaper of the city.~~

~~The motion carried, and it was so ordered.~~

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to enter into a contract with the owner of Lot 3 and the west one-half of Lot 4, in Block 127, City of Grand Junction, the City to pay \$1,662.50 for same; \$100.00 at the time the contract is signed, the balance to be paid by January 15, 1914; provided, the owner has removed all buildings therefrom.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Carson, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the Council adjourned.
