

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 30, 1913.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Verbeck, Rankin, Carson, Helmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of December 23d and adjourned session of December 26th were read and approved.

A communication from Barten & Terrill, making application for the city freight hauling, was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the city freight hauling, excepting shipments in carload lots, be given to Barten & Terrill for the year 1914.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and it was so ordered.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayer declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Approving the Whole Cost of Improvements made in and for Paving District No. 3, in the City of Grand Junction, etc." was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the proof of publication as read was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the proposed ordinance be taken up for final passage.

The motion carried, and the proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the proposed ordinance as read and entitled "An Ordinance Approving the Whole Cost of Improvements made in and for Paving District Number 3, in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, pursuant to Ordinance Number 175, adopted and approved June 11, 1910, and pursuant to Resolutions and Proceedings of the City Council adopted pursuant to said ordinance, approving the Apportionment of said Costs to each Lot or Tract of Land, or other Real Estate, in said District, Assessing the Share of said Cost against each Lot or Tract of Land, or other Real Estate, in said District, and Prescribing the Manner for the Collection and Payment of said Assessments," be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayer declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 219.

The motion carried, and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carson, the Council adjourned until to-morrow, December 31, at 2 o'clock p. m.
